## 2026 Policies & Procedures

---

### DISCLAIMER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

The rules and regulations set forth herein are intended to establish minimum acceptable requirements for the orderly conduct of racing events at Grayson County Speedway ("GCS"). These rules govern all events conducted at GCS. By entering the premises or participating in any event, all participants, spectators, officials, crew members, and guests acknowledge that they have read, understand, and agree to comply with these rules.

Auto racing is a dangerous activity involving the risk of serious injury or death. **No expressed or implied warranty of safety** shall result from the publication of, or compliance with, these rules and/or regulations. These rules are not intended as a guarantee against injury, death, or property damage to any participant, spectator, official, or other person.

The Race Director and Team GCS officials are authorized to permit minor deviations from these rules or impose additional restrictions as deemed necessary, provided such actions do not reduce minimum safety requirements. Any interpretation of or deviation from these rules shall be at the sole discretion of Team GCS officials, whose decisions shall be final and binding.

**Team GCS** refers to all owners, promoters, officials, employees, agents, contractors, and representatives of Grayson County Speedway.

### GENERAL POLICIES

- Team GCS reserves the right to alter, amend, delay, cancel, or reschedule any race program at any time.
  - Team GCS reserves the right to refuse admission to or remove any car, driver, owner, crew member, or spectator from any area of the facility.
  - All persons entering the premises do so at their own risk.
  - All persons entering the pit area must personally sign the required Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement.
  - GCS assumes no responsibility for accidents, personal injury, death, property damage, or theft occurring on the premises.

## **RAINOUT POLICY**

- If all scheduled heat races are completed, the event will be considered official and start money only will be paid.
  - If all heat races are not completed, pit passes or general admission ticket stubs may be used for free entry to one regular Saturday Night event within the next two (2) weeks.

## **CONDUCT, DISCIPLINE & SOCIAL MEDIA**

- Disorderly conduct, including but not limited to fighting, vulgar language, harassment, threats, or inappropriate behavior, will not be tolerated.
  - Unsportsmanlike conduct toward Team GCS officials, staff, competitors, or spectators may result in immediate removal, suspension, permanent suspension, and/or additional penalties. Penalties may be cumulative and imposed at the sole discretion of Team GCS.
  - Malicious, defamatory, or disruptive public statements or social media posts regarding GCS, its staff, competitors, or sponsors may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of competition privileges.
  - GCS maintains a family-friendly environment. Foul language and unsportsmanlike conduct are strictly prohibited in all spectator and pit areas.

## **ALCOHOL, DRUGS & PROHIBITED ITEMS**

- Consumption or possession of alcohol by drivers or crew members prior to or during race events is strictly prohibited.
  - Any person in the pit area suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be immediately removed.
  - No alcohol consumption is permitted on GCS property after curfew.
  - Glass containers are strictly prohibited.
  - Illegal drugs are prohibited on or around GCS property.
  - Firearms or weapons of any kind are prohibited on GCS property.
  - Persons injured while under the influence of alcohol or drugs forfeit all rights to insurance coverage or claims.

## **PROTESTS & CLAIMS**

- Protests must be filed with the Pit Steward immediately following completion of heat races.
- A cash deposit of \$250 is required per protested item; \$50 is non-refundable.
- If the protested item is deemed legal, the remaining deposit is forfeited.
- If the protested item is deemed illegal, the deposit minus the \$50 fee will be refunded to the protester.
- Refusal to submit to protest inspection will result in disqualification, loss of pay and points, and mandatory re-inspection prior to future participation.

- Team GCS reserves the right to refuse any protest. All protest decisions are final and not subject to appeal.

## **RACE PROCEDURES & LINEUPS**

- Heat races: 8 laps
- A-Feature: 20 laps (subject to change at promoter discretion)

Lineups shall be determined by draw, IMCA point average, inversion, or official discretion as outlined in posted race procedures. Officials reserve the right to relocate any driver for safety or competitive balance.

## **FLAGS**

- Green: Start of race
  - Yellow: Caution
  - Red: Stop immediately
  - Black: Exit track and report to Pit Steward
  - White: One lap remaining
  - Checkered: End of race

## **DISQUALIFICATIONS & PENALTIES**

- Intentional contact after the display of the red, yellow, or checkered flag will result in disqualification.
  - Rough driving or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in loss of pay and points.
  - Failure to obey a black flag may result in disqualification.
  - Drivers must remain in their vehicles during events unless directed otherwise by officials or in the event of fire.

## **PIT & PADDOCK RULES**

- Auxiliary pit vehicles must be operated safely and by individuals at least sixteen (16) years of age.
  - Pit areas will close one (1) hour after completion of the final race.

## **REGISTRATION & CAR NUMBERS**

- All drivers and cars must be registered with GCS prior to competition.
  - Driver changes must be reported and approved.
  - Each car/class requires separate registration and pit pass.

## **MINORS**

- Minimum driver age is twelve (12) years.
  - Drivers under eighteen (18) years of age must have notarized parental consent and Minor Release and Waiver of Liability on file.
  - No exceptions will be granted. Failure to comply with minor participation requirements voids insurance coverage and competition eligibility.

## **PAYOUTS**

- Winnings must be collected at the designated payout window within one (1) hour of the final race.
  - Failure to collect winnings within the designated time constitutes forfeiture until the following race event.

## **SAFETY & TECHNICAL RULES**

- Snell-rated SA2005, SA2010, or SA2015 helmet required.
  - SFI-approved full fire suit, safety belts, window net, and kill switch required.
  - All vehicles are subject to safety and technical inspection at any time.
  - Approval of a vehicle does not constitute a warranty of mechanical safety.

## **AFTER RACE & MISCELLANEOUS**

- Injuries must be reported prior to leaving the premises.
  - Special events may be governed by supplemental rules.
  - Any matter not specifically covered herein shall be determined by Team GCS officials.

Execution of the Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement constitutes acknowledgment and acceptance of all Grayson County Speedway Policies and Procedures, including any amendments, supplemental rules, or special event regulations.
